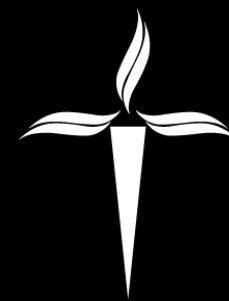

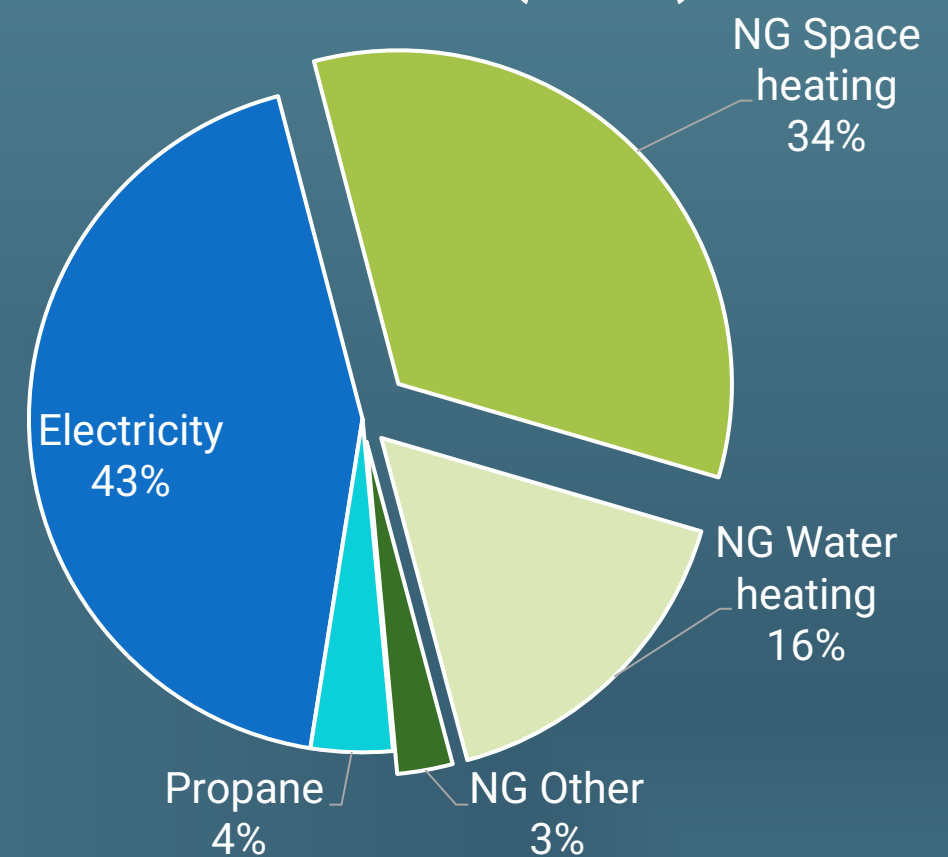
CLEAN HEAT 101

As of 2020, 2 out of 3 buildings in the Mountain West use fossil gas for space heating, water heating, cooking, or some combination of heating needs.

Electrifying space and water heating

- Reduces greenhouse gas emissions compared with fossil gas
- Improves indoor air quality and public health
- Uses energy efficiently and can save money
- Can benefit the power grid
