As a program and legal assistant at Western Resource Advocates (WRA), Allison George provides administrative and legal support to the Clean Energy team in Arizona. Working alongside the attorney and senior policy advisor in Arizona, George monitors cases and submits filings at the Arizona Corporation Commission, assists with the drafting and editing of legal documents, and manages the organization’s Phoenix office.
